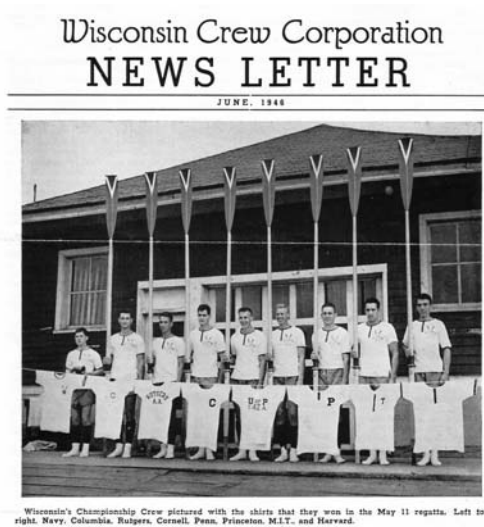


Invitation to the Boat Dedication of the “Crew of ’46”
